Public Notice is hereby given that the 2024 Annual Meeting Schedule of the Human Rights Commission of Salt Lake City, Utah, shall be as follows:

The Human Rights Commission (HRC) holds meetings on the 1st Tuesday of every other month starting in January and ending in November. In November, the meeting will be held on the 2nd Tuesday due to Election Day on the 1st Tuesday. These meetings are typically held at 5:30 PM.

Meetings are currently being held in Hybrid 1 status, meaning the public can attend only in person at the City and County Building, Room 335, 451 S State St., Salt Lake City, Utah 84111.

All Human Rights Commission meetings are open to the public unless closed pursuant to Sections 52-4-204, 52-4-205, and 52-4-206, Utah Code Annotated. Notice of each HRC meeting is given at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting as required by State law. An agenda of each meeting is posted at:
