SLC Firefighter Candidate E-Tip: Registration details for the 2020 Hiring (Test) Preparation Events

Beginning January 2020, we will host a series of Firefighter Candidate Hiring (Test) Preparation events. The events are open to all firefighter candidates. Candidates may attend all three series: Written Exam, Oral Board Assessment, and CPAT. Each series is hosted on a Friday night and Saturday morning each month between January and March 2020. Candidates may attend one session per series. (You can attend a Friday night OR Saturday morning event, NOT BOTH, per series.) Registration for these events is first come, first served and will be available at jobs.slcfire.com. Below are the pertinent details for each series.

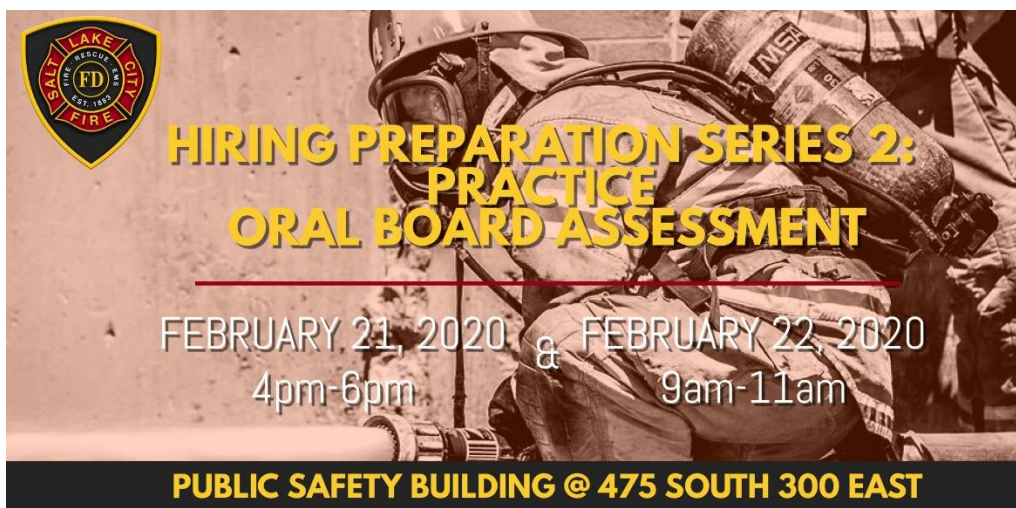

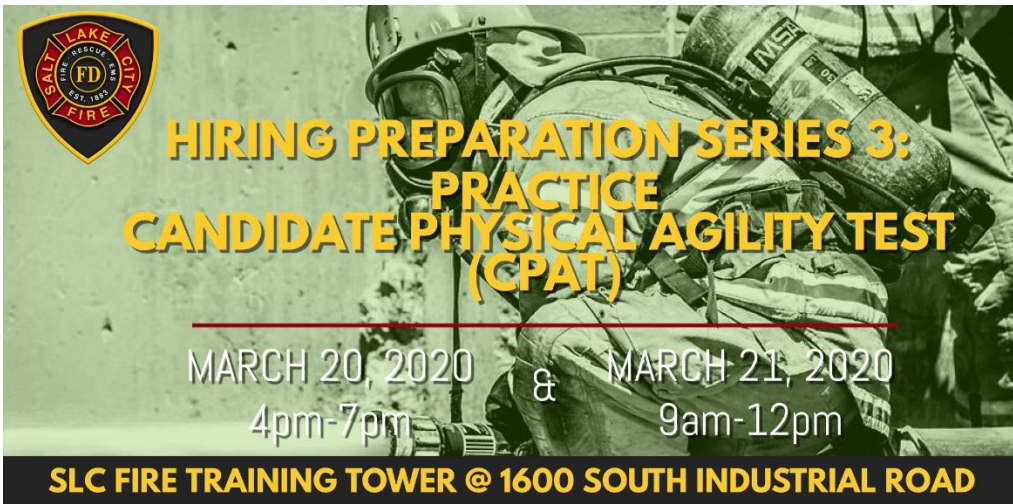

The interview questions will be pulled from previous SLC Firefighter I (Entry-Level Firefighter) Oral Board Assessment banks. The mock interview will be conducted in a large group setting.

Series 3: Practice Candidate Physical Agility Test (CPAT)

Event description: **Series 3 attendees will see a demonstration of the eight CPAT physical events: stair climb, hose drag, equipment carry, ladder raise & extension, forcible entry, search, rescue, and ceiling breach & pull. Following the demonstration(s), candidates will get to try each event.**

Candidates can anticipate receiving attendance notifications via email. A waiting list will be created for candidates who register after attendance maximums are reached. We will extend additional invitations, to those on the waiting list, pending cancellations.
