Salt Lake City Fire Department works every day of the year to protect our capital city, Salt Lake City, Utah. All lives, all structures: SLC Fire serves them.







SLC Fire has a plan for combatting fires and protecting life and property for all kinds of structures in our city. Structures that hold and shape our lives, culture, and history.







Salt Lake City Fire has a plan for fighting fires that happen in high-rise buildings in Salt Lake City. A high-rise building is six or more windows high. The tallest building in SLC currently is the Wells Fargo Building at 26 floors.

Gas stations and other places that have hazardous materials on site are a particular challenge for firefighters but don't worry, we have specialists that can safely handle the emergency.
