<u>Tier 1 - Signature Event Application</u> Tier 1: \$5,000 - \$10,000

Tier 1 funding is for "signature events," which are large scale events with a significant footprint in the city, including a tangible economic development impact. Tier 1 events should have multiple sources of revenue, including multiple sponsors, and a manageable budget. Applicants for Tier 1 funding should submit a detailed and strong application as this is a competitive process.

To be eligible for this funding, events must be established and have been taking place for 3 years or more. These events must also be in-person - virtual events are not eligible for Tier 1 funding. All events MUST take place in Salt Lake City. If your event is located outside the city limits, you're not eligible for ACE Funding.
