JOINT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING APRIL 12th AS EDUCATION & SHARING DAY IN SALT LAKE CITY

WHEREAS, *Education and Sharing Day is observed annually on the 11th day of the Jewish month of Nisan, which this year falls on April 12th, 2022; and*


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,


