



# JORDAN PARKWAY PEDESTRIAN PATHWAYS & EVENT GROUNDS

## PROJECT BACKGROUND

Jordan Park is located along the Jordan River Parkway and adjacent to several other Public Lands managed properties including the 900 South River Park and the Fife Wetland Preserve. The busy park has a full range of recreation opportunities but lacks good internal connectivity as well as connectivity to adjacent Public Lands sites and neighborhoods. The primary goal of this project is to increase pedestrian connectivity throughout the park spaces and to the neighborhood by way of a looped circulation network with wayfinding signage and amenities.

## WHAT SORT OF IMPROVEMENTS CAN WE EXPECT TO SEE?

This project will design and implement new looped circulation elements and a new self-contained event area. The project includes the following three separately funded projects, which will improve circulation and access to the site through the creation of looped paths.

### JORDAN PARK EVENT GROUNDS

- New electric service for event areas
- New pathways to event zones to allow access and circulation
- Large self-contained event site for the West Side
- Enhanced access to Jordan River's edge

### WEST SIDE COMMUNITY TRAILS

- New and improved trail connections between park and Jordan River
- Wayfinding signage

### JORDAN PARK PATHWAYS

- New looped pathways in Jordan Park and around multi-use fields
- Site furnishings
- Wayfinding signage

## WHAT AREAS WILL BE AFFECTED?

Any of the Jordan Park and River Walk between Indiana Avenue and California Avenue is being considered and looked at for design recommendations.

## WHEN WILL THESE CHANGES TAKE PLACE?

Construction is currently planned for Summer 2023.
