Dear Secretary Buttigieg:

On behalf of Building Salt Lake, I write in support of Salt Lake City's initiative to address east-west connections across the I-15 and north-south rail corridors, particularly for people walking, biking, and taking transit.

There isn't a more profound divide in Salt Lake City than the one posed by the train and Interstate corridor - it separates people, neighborhoods, ideas, cultures and commerce.

Waiting for trains to pass in order to cross the city is archaic, and hurts the ability of people to connect across differences in the city.

The safety and convenience sacrifices Salt Lake City residents make on a daily basis can be remedied by initiatives like the Rio Grande Plan. The Plan also promises to lift train transport in the Wasatch Front area significantly.

A restoration of the Rio Grande terminal, and integration of city, metro, regional, and national network rail networks would be a huge boon to the region's environmental and economic sustainability prospects.
