- 1. All application submissions must be fully complete and submitted through ZoomGrants: https://www.zoomgrants.com/zgf/2026-27 Capital Improvement Program
- 2. All applications must include an official cost estimate prepared by the collaborating City division before final submissions.
- 3. All applications must be completed by stated deadline to be eligible for consideration and funding.
- 4. Any additional documentation (letters of support, pictures of current asset condition, etc.) that support the application are welcomed and can be uploaded for review under the Documents tab.
- 5. All application questions will be directed through the City's CIP Manager, *cipinfo@slc.gov*
- 6. Please be aware that City Council appropriation of CIP funding for a particular project does not guarantee that the City will ultimately implement and complete that project. The City reserves the right to withdraw or reappropriate funding for any project at the City's sole discretion. The City has withdrawn or reappropriated funding from projects in the past, and it is anticipated that circumstances requiring the withdrawal or reappropriation of funding for projects will arise in the future.
