

CIP Expectations:

1. All application submissions must be fully complete and submitted through ZoomGrants: [https://www.zoomgrants.com/zgf/Salt\\_Lake\\_City/2022-23\\_Capital\\_Improvement\\_Program](https://www.zoomgrants.com/zgf/Salt_Lake_City/2022-23_Capital_Improvement_Program)
2. All applications must include an official cost estimate prepared by the collaborating City division before final submissions.
3. All applications must be completed by stated deadline to be eligible for consideration and funding.
4. Any additional documentation (letters of support, pictures of current asset condition, etc.) that support the application are welcomed and can be uploaded for review under the documents tab.
