### STEPS TO TAKE

- Look for cracks in the foundation
- Look for damage to exterior or interior walls, including cracks, ceiling and floor issues, lighting damage, windows and doors that do not open properly and roof damage
- Take photos to document the damage
- Contact your city if you need assistance

### SURVEY

Salt Lake City needs to know how extensive the damage from the earthquake is. If your home or business has visible damage, please take this survey. You can request an inspection while you're at it.
