**WHEREAS**, Survivors at the Summit, now in its 29th year, brings together cancer survivors, caregivers, loved ones, and supporters for a day of healing and remembrance in the mountains above Salt Lake City; and

**WHEREAS**, each July, participants gather at Brighton Resort in Big Cottonwood Canyon to hike, share meals, listen to music, and raise a sea of yellow Tribute Flags—each one inscribed with names, messages of hope, and memories that represent lives changed and courage shown; and

**WHEREAS**, this annual event, organized by the Salt Lake City-based nonprofit Survivor Wellness, helps ensure that integrative, whole-person support—like counseling, massage therapy, grief support, and peer connection—remains accessible to those navigating cancer and survivorship in our community; and
