WHEREAS, the construction industry plays a vital role in shaping Salt Lake City—building the homes we live in, the roads we travel, and the spaces where our community gathers and grows; and

WHEREAS, women have made—and continue to make—significant contributions across every sector of the construction industry, expanding opportunities, breaking barriers, and helping lead projects that define our skyline and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC), founded in 1953, and its Salt Lake City Chapter #90, chartered in 1964, have for decades supported and advanced women in the construction industry through education, mentorship, and workforce development, strengthening both the industry and our local community; and

WHEREAS, Women in Construction Week, established by NAWIC, is recognized each year during the first week of March as a time to celebrate the achievements of women in construction, raise awareness of career opportunities in the trades, engineering, and related fields, and inspire the next generation of leaders in the built environment; and

WHEREAS, recognizing Women in Construction Week reflects Salt Lake City’s commitment to fostering a strong, skilled, and inclusive workforce that represents the talent and determination of our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Erin Mendenhall, Salt Lake City Mayor, do hereby proclaim the first week of March as:
