



2700 South Reconstruction: Highland Drive to Preston Street

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE | May 9, 2019

We are reconstructing this segment of 2700 South to improve mobility, access and prolong the lifespan of the street. These are the activities our construction crews will be working on over the next few weeks:

- Crews have been replacing concrete elements along 2700 South from 1700 East going westbound along the north side of the road. Crews will continue to work on the north side of the street replacing more concrete elements towards 1300 East. Once crews reach 1300 East, they will come back to work near Highland Elementary and continue eastbound along the south side of the street to replace concrete elements along 2700 South. Expect detours for pedestrian travel as well as one lane, two-way traffic flagging operations to ease travel conditions while crews are working.
- Crews will be working on concrete elements, including the pedestrian ramps at Kenwood, between 1800 East and 1700 East along the north side of 2700 South, starting with removal activities on Friday, May 17 followed by construction work the next day. Crews will sequence this activity to allow access at the Kenwood crosswalk near the school on Friday. Flaggers will assist everyone using that crosswalk as they travel to and from the school.
- The sewer work to replace and repair portions of the sewer line near Imperial Drive and Grandview Circle has been postponed until school is out for the summer.

Work is expected Monday - Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and is subject to change. Expect work activities to also occur on Saturday, May 18.

Our team is committed to assist in maintaining access to properties throughout construction, as much as possible. Certain activities such as driveway replacements, that don't allow for a split construction and curing, will temporarily hinder your access with a vehicle. On-street parking is still prohibited. Garbage collection is anticipated to continue as regularly scheduled. We'll assist where and when we can with any events and issues that may be planned or arise. Please contact us at any time.
