

2700 SOUTH CONSTRUCTION UPDATE | May 31, 2019



These are the activities our construction crews will be working on over the next two weeks:

- Crews have been replacing concrete elements along 2700 South near Highland Elementary and should be completed up to 2000 East.
- Crews will double back and begin work at 1640 east and continue West along 2700 south toward 1300 East.
- Expect detours for pedestrian travel as well as one lane, two-way traffic flagging operations to ease travel conditions while crews are working.
- Crews will be working on concrete elements, including the pedestrian ramps at Kenwood, between 1800 East and 1700 East along the north side of 2700 South, starting with removal activities this Friday, May 31 followed by the pour back work on Saturday June 1st.
- Crews will sequence this activity to allow access at the Kenwood crosswalk near the school on Friday.
- Flaggers will assist everyone using that crosswalk as they travel to and from the school.
- The crosswalk will be open to pedestrians the following Monday June 3rd.
- The sewer work to replace and repair portions of the sewer line near Imperial Drive and Grandview Circle has been postponed until school is out for the summer.
 - This work is scheduled to begin June 10th.
- The full closure of 2700 South from Preston Street thru 1700 East is expected to begin June 6th and will continue to be fully closed while the reconstruction of the roadway is completed in that section.
 - This work is expected to take 3 weeks.
- Work is expected Monday - Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and is subject to change.
- Our team is committed to assist in maintaining access to properties throughout construction, as much as possible.
- Certain activities such as driveway replacements, that don't allow for a split construction and curing, will temporarily hinder your access with a vehicle.
- On-street parking is still prohibited.
- Garbage collection is anticipated to continue as regularly scheduled.
