1300 EAST CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Reminder

 1300 East: 2100 South to 1700 South is CLOSED to all through-traffic. The road will remain closed through the end of July, and will not re-open at any time. Please use an alternate route.

Upcoming Work Activities

- Removal of the concrete layer of the roadway between 2100
 South and 1700 South is underway. This process will continue through the next week and a half. Nearby residents and businesses should expect increased noise and vibrations during this work.
- Curb and gutter is being removed concurrently with the concrete layer of the road. Resident driveway approaches will be left intact until the time comes to replace them.
- In areas where the concrete has already been removed, the team is now excavating the road down to the new subgrade level.
- Crews are working on the installation of new gas line facilities from 2100 South to near Westminster Ave. Temporary outages of gas line services during day time hours for the next two weeks are possible.
- Storm drain installation will take place intermittently throughout the closed section of 1300 East, as well across the 2100 South/1300 East intersection. Intersection work will take place mainly at night.
- Crews will be out working up to seven days a week to make up for time lost due to rain delays.

Traffic Alerts

- The traffic control set-up on 1300 East, just south of the 2100 South intersection, has changed. Please use extra caution driving through the area, as everyone becomes familiar with the new configuration.
- Local residents accessing their homes in the closed area of 1300 East are reminded that traffic now flows ONLY NORTHBOUND from 2100 South to Westminster Avenue. For homes located between 2100 South and Westminster Avenue, please enter the work zone off of 2100 South, and then travel north to your home. When leaving, please head northbound to Westminster Avenue. Please note that there may be occasional delays for entering the work zone at 2100 South when trucks have to be loaded or unloaded there. At those times, expect between 5-15 minute delays.
