

1300 EAST CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

JUNE 14, 2019

Reminder

- **1300 East: 2100 South to 1700 South is CLOSED to all through-traffic. The road will remain closed through the end of July, and will not re-open at any time. Please use an alternate route.**

Upcoming Work Activities

- The team is currently excavating the road down to the new subgrade level, and will start bringing in granular borrow on June 24. Granular borrow is the first section of the new road that will be installed.
- Crews are working on the installation of new gas line facilities from 2100 S. to near Westminster Ave. Temporary outages of gas line services during day-time hours during the next week are possible.
- Storm drain installation will take place intermittently throughout the closed section of 1300 East, as well across the 2100 South/1300 East intersection. Intersection work will take place mainly at night. This activity is anticipated to be completed in about two and a half more weeks.
- Fiber line installation is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 17.
- Some concrete pavement, curb, and gutter still need to be removed, but this activity will be put on hold for a couple weeks while other work takes place, giving the subgrade time to dry out after all the recent rain.
- Crews will be out working up to seven days a week to make up for time lost due to rain delays.



Traffic Alerts

- Local residents accessing their homes in the closed area of 1300 East are reminded that traffic now flows **ONLY NORTHBOUND** from 2100 South to Westminster Avenue. For homes located between 2100 South and Westminster Avenue, please enter the work zone off of 2100 South, and then travel north to your home. When leaving, please head northbound to Westminster Avenue. **Please note that there may be occasional delays for entering the work zone at 2100 South when trucks have to be loaded or unloaded there. At those times, expect between 5-15 minute delays.**

Safety:

- Pedestrians walking along the work zone are reminded to stay on the sidewalks, and to only cross the road at designated locations, to avoid the many tripping hazards that exist in an active construction area.
- Motorists are reminded to watch out for trucks entering and leaving the work zone. Please make eye contact with the operators of the equipment before proceeding into the work zone. This will help ensure that you are safe and clear to pass. Also, please mind the flagger that is assisting with the safe flow of traffic.
