

WHAT TO EXPECT IN PHASE 2




The reconstruction of 1300 East (Phase 2) is anticipated to be completed in Fall 2020. Here is what to expect:

- 1300 East, from 1700 South to 1300 South, will be CLOSED to through-traffic from May-October 2020. Local access will be provided for residents and businesses within the closed segment.
 - UTA Bus Route 220 will be temporarily rerouted.
- Construction teams will work up to seven days a week. Expect dust, noise, large equipment, vibration, and occasional night-work associated with construction.
- Crews will finish minor work in the Phase 1 segment:
 - Placement of a final top-seal coat on the roadway, to protect the new asphalt
 - Outstanding landscaping activities
 - Placement of permanent striping
- To limit the amount of unexpected conflicts, utility exploration will be more in-depth to verify the location of shallow utilities that may impact drainage installation. Utilities will be relocated as needed before paving activities begin.
- When the project is completed, there will be two travel lanes, a center turn lane, and bike lanes on both sides of 1300 East. There will be **no more street parking along 1300 East, from 1700 South to 1300 South.**


