

1300 EAST CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

SEPTEMBER 4, 2020

Upcoming Work Activities:

- *In observance of Labor Day, no work will take place on the project from September 5-7.*
- Crews are working on roadway demolition and excavation in the 1300 East/1300 South intersection. This process will take 2-3 more weeks to complete, depending on potential utility conflicts.
- As early as Wednesday, September 9, crews will pour the new curb and gutter on the **west** side of the road.
- Crews will continue the process of replacing driveway approaches and sidewalk panels on both sides of the roadway over the next three weeks.
 - *We remind residents and pedestrians to not walk or drive on newly-poured concrete, as it requires several days of cure time.*



Traffic Alerts

- To accommodate work in the 1300 East/1300 South intersection, **east-bound movements through the intersection are CLOSED.** West-bound movements down 1300 South continue as usual, though motorists should anticipate driving on road-base after the asphalt is removed.
 - *East-bound motorists on 1300 South prior to 1300 East will need to detour north on 1100 East, east on 900 South, and then south on 1500 East to get back to east-bound 1300 South.* This detour is expected to be in place up to **three more weeks**, though traffic patterns are subject to change as work progresses.
- 1300 East: 1700 South to 1300 South is **CLOSED** to all-through traffic. Suggested detour routes include: 2100 South, 1300 South, and 800 South/Sunnyside Avenue to Foothill Drive, State Street, or 700 East.

Safety:

- We remind residents accessing their homes in the closed area of 1300 East to drive **slowly** through the work zone and to use caution. Remember, **ONLY NORTHBOUND** traffic is allowed from 1700 South to 1300 South. Please be attentive to the changing work zone conditions.
- We want to remind people traveling on the sidewalks that **this is an ACTIVE WORK ZONE.** When walking through the area, you must remember to look around you, to **cross the street at designated crossing areas only**, and to make eye contact with equipment operators so they know you are there.
- *Pedestrian routes through the area are changing often.* Please pay attention to signs marking where sidewalks are closed, and where you should be walking.
- During construction, drivers are reminded to watch out for trucks entering and leaving the work zone, and to follow directions from flaggers on-site assisting with the safe flow of traffic.
