

# 1300 EAST CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

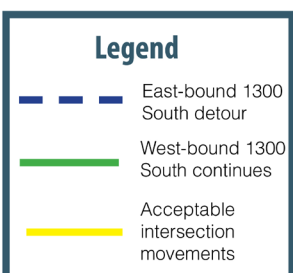

## Upcoming Work Activities:

- Crews continue working on roadway demolition and excavation in the 1300 East/1300 South intersection, through the end of this week.
- Crews will be working through this weekend to fine-grade the road in preparation for paving operations to begin on Monday, September 21.
- Crews will suspend the process of replacing driveway approaches and sidewalk panels on both sides of the roadway during paving operations, but will resume this activity on Monday, September 28. They have about three more weeks of work to do to complete this item.
  - *We remind residents and pedestrians to not walk or drive on newly-poured concrete, as it requires several days of cure time.*
- Asphalt paving is scheduled to begin on Monday, September 21, weather depending. Paving is expected to take about one week to complete.
- On Monday and Tuesday, September 28 and 29, crews will grind sections of the new asphalt, to remove bumps and ridges where needed. Grinding improves the smoothness of the road.

## Traffic Alerts

- **East-bound movements through the 1300 East/1300 South intersection remain CLOSED through Sunday night, September 20.** See map for detour route, and please avoid using small, residential roads as detours.
- To accommodate asphalt paving in **the 1300 East/1300 South intersection**, the intersection will be **CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC on Monday, September 21**, from about 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. The intersection will re-open to all traffic late Monday night.
  - *Please Note: There will be one 30-minute closure of the 1300 East/1300 South intersection to all traffic on Thursday, September 24, and two 30-minute closures of the intersection on Friday, September 25, to accommodate additional asphalt paving.*
- 1300 East: 1700 South to 1300 South is **CLOSED** to all-through traffic. Suggested detour routes include: 2100 South, 1300 South, and 800 South/Sunnyside Avenue to Foothill Drive, State Street, or 700 East.



## Safety:

- There has been an increase in speeding through the work zone. **Please SLOW DOWN. Many road hazards exist in an active construction area**, and those driving through need to do so slowly to prevent damage to their vehicle and help reduce the amount of dust in the area.
- We remind residents accessing their homes in the closed area of 1300 East to drive **slowly** through the work zone and to use caution. Remember, **ONLY NORTHBOUND** traffic is allowed from 1700 South to 1300 South. Please be attentive to the changing work zone conditions.
- We want to remind people traveling on the sidewalks that **this is an ACTIVE WORK ZONE**. When walking through the area, you must remember to look around you, to **cross the street at designated crossing areas only**, and to make eye contact with equipment operators so they know you are there.
- *Pedestrian routes through the area are changing often.* Please pay attention to signs marking where sidewalks are closed, and where you should be walking.
- During construction, drivers are reminded to watch out for trucks entering and leaving the work zone, and to follow directions from flaggers on-site assisting with the safe flow of traffic.
