

1300 EAST CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

OCTOBER 2, 2020

Upcoming Work Activities:

- Crews are now working to raise utilities, buried deep in the roadway at the start of the project to accommodate asphalt removal, back up to street level. This activity will take about 1 1/2 weeks to complete.
- On Friday and Saturday night, October 2 and 3, crews will be working to remove and replace the asphalt in the 2100 South/1300 East intersection.
- Crews will continue working to replace driveway approaches and sidewalk panels on both sides of the roadway through October 26.
 - *We remind residents and pedestrians to not walk or drive on newly-poured concrete, as it requires several days of cure time.*
- Landscape restoration along the corridor will begin mid-week next week, and is planned to continue through early November.
- A microsurface is scheduled to be applied to the entire length of the 1300 East project (2100 South to 1300 South) on Monday and Tuesday, October 19 and 20.
 - Microsurface is a pavement surface treatment that will extend the life of the new asphalt.

Traffic Alerts

- To accommodate work in the 2100 South/1300 East intersection, **only right-turn movements will be permitted through the intersection from any direction from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. nightly from Friday night, October 2, through Sunday morning, October 4.**
- 1300 East: 1700 South to 1300 South **REMAINS CLOSED to all-through traffic AT ALL TIMES.** Suggested detour routes include: 2100 South, 1300 South, and 800 South/Sunnyside Avenue to Foothill Drive, State Street, or 700 East.



Safety:

- We remind residents accessing their homes in the closed area of 1300 East to drive **slowly** through the work zone and to use caution. Please make eye contact with operators before passing any equipment. This will help ensure that you are safe and clear to pass. Also, please mind the flaggers that are assisting with the safe flow of traffic.
- Pedestrians walking through the construction zone are reminded that even though the road is closed to the public, residential traffic and construction vehicles are still actively driving in the area. For your safety, **please only cross the road at designated crossing areas.**
- *Pedestrian routes through the area are changing often.* Please pay attention to signs marking where sidewalks are closed, and where you should be walking.
- Motorists are reminded to watch out for trucks entering and leaving the work zone.
