The community-led application titled "McClelland Shared Street Improvements" is a welcome project for Salt Lake City's Parks and Public Lands. It is consistent with our mission *to enhance the livability of the urban environment through a diverse network of natural open spaces, recreational opportunities, park facilities, a cemetery and urban forests, and insure that the resources under our management are carefully stewarded for future generations.*
