We have a number of developments along this corridor and connectivity in this area is a critical component to the ongoing growth and success of this area. We have focused much of our development the last 10 years on sustainable transit-oriented projects and continue to find that there is a major divide in the city between the west and east side of the city because of the dividing highways and railways that intersect the city. We often have a difficult time getting people to abandon their historic demand for cars because of the inability to safely and successfully cross these dividing transit corridors. In many cases this undermines our ability to really provide sustainable, green developments. We are very supportive of the efforts of Salt Lake City to address this major initiative in our community.
