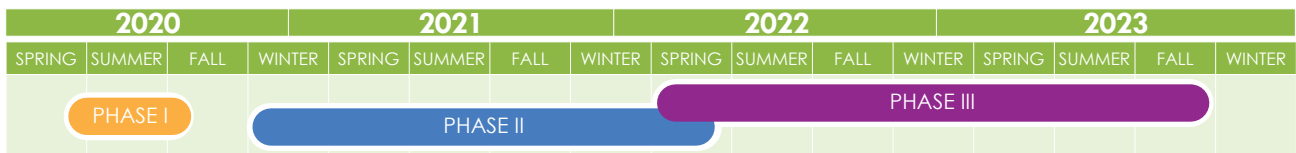
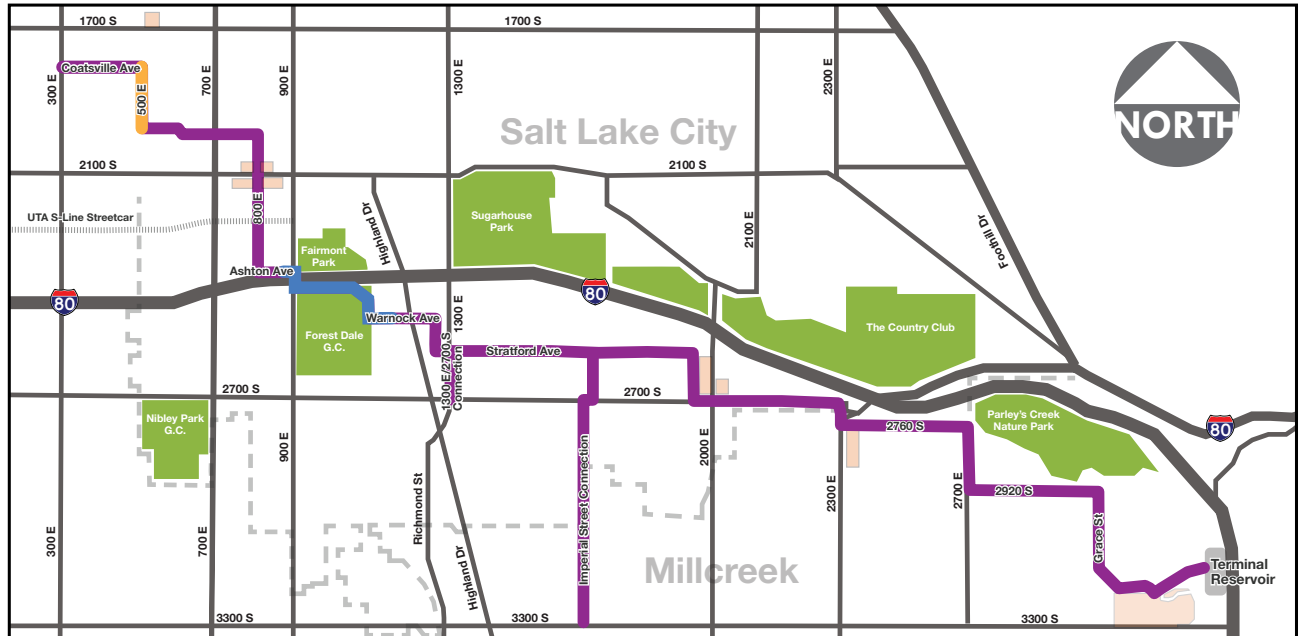




Salt Lake City Department of Public Utilities (SLCDPU) is constructing a new water line from the storage reservoir at 3300 South and 3500 East to 300 East.

## Project Purpose

The 6-mile water line will provide an additional water supply to supplement existing wells in the Sugarhouse area as well as maintain SLCDPU's standard of reliability while meeting future growth's water demands in Salt Lake City.

## Anticipated Schedule

Beginning in Summer 2020 with completion anticipated in 2023, this project will be constructed in three phases based on funding and coordination with surrounding SLC projects.

As design and construction gets underway, effected communities will be notified of any potential impacts which may include roadway construction, increased noise, and dust.

<b>Quick Facts</b>	<b>What:</b>	Construction of a new water line from 3500 East to 300 East.
	<b>When:</b>	Phase I construction is anticipated to begin summer 2020. Additional phases will continue through 2023.
	<b>Why:</b>	Provide additional water supply, supplement existing wells, maintain standard of reliability, and meet future water demands in the city.
